

9 Mile Road Shiraz 2012



Variety: 100% Shiraz

Region: 100% Coonawarra

Tasting Note: Bright maroon in colour. Vibrant and fresh with red cherry, plum and subtle mocha finish on the nose. The velvety tannins integrate well with the fruit complexity and fresh acidity. The wine is well rounded with loads of personality; the length and persistence of flavour is an obvious and positive aspect of this parcel.

Notes about the vintage: 2012 was a great year all round for quality, with an even ripening and cool nights during February and March resulting in wines with excellent acid and flavour balance.

Oak Influence: The wine was matured in 65% French and 35% American Oak. The oak was 2005 (97%) and 2006(3%); and

the total split between hogshead and barrique was 86% and 14% respectively.
